



## **GUIDELINES FOR SPORT**

### **POLICY 1: CURRICULUM GUIDELINE 4**

St. Benedict's School takes a full and active role in zone and interschool sports where possible.

A wide range of sports is introduced to our students.

Team members must be currently enrolled members of St. Benedict's School unless by prior arrangement with both the Principal and the Teacher in Charge. In this circumstance, the player is a guest of the school and is expected to abide with the St. Benedict's Sports Code of Conduct.

The focus of school teams is participation, enjoyment and fair play. As much as possible teams will be made up of children with a range of skills, this allows those with more skill to teach those not so skilled as well as providing an opportunity for all students to demonstrate the Gospel Values when representing St Benedict's School.

Teachers, coaches, and leaders are encouraged to assist and support sporting ventures and to share their skills with students.

Parents are encouraged to assist and support sporting ventures and to share their skills with students.

Coaches and managers will be informed of our school philosophy and procedures for team selection and running of teams. These are included in the Induction Pack presented upon enrolment.

Coaches, players, officials and supporters will abide by the Sports Code of Conduct(4c)

Processes are established for dealing with inappropriate behaviour and for recognising appropriate behaviours.

All financial arrangements concerning funding and management of teams organised through the school require the approval of the Board of Trustees.
