Message from The Archdiocese of Wellington:

This years dues for each primary student is \$485. Attendance Dues are the compulsory property and insurance fee which you legally commit to pay when you enrol your child(ren) in a Catholic school. The money collected from Attendance Dues are used to then pay for the costs of new school classrooms, gymnasiums and other buildings, pay off existing mortgages and pay for the insurance on all school property.

You will receive your first invoice in February and payment in full is due by **30 April 2018.** If you are unable to pay the full amount you can make an arrangement to pay over the year in regular instalments. Please contact the Archdiocese Attendance dues team to set up a payment plan or to discuss your situation if you are experiencing genuine and undue hardship.


